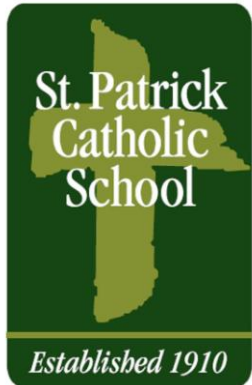

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## Computer and Internet Use Policy 2011 - 2012

The purpose of the computer resources at St. Patrick Catholic School is for exploration of information by students and staff. Maintaining quality resources will require the best efforts of all users. Each user is responsible for adhering to school policy.

1. All use of the Internet must be in support of education and research consistent with the philosophy of St. Patrick School.
2. Every Internet user is responsible to respect and protect the rights of every other user in our school and on the Internet. All who use this resource are expected to act in a responsible, ethical, moral and legal manner.
3. Students may not download or install any software program, music, video or computer game on any school computer without permission from the Computer Teacher or the Principal.
4. A student may not submit his or her email address and/or name at any time while using the Internet. Students shall not subscribe to email mailing lists, online contests or any other activity without express permission from the Computer Teacher.
5. No user has the right to tamper with hardware, software, or other equipment.
6. Each user is responsible for reporting any damage discovered or equipment missing.
7. In the computer lab, library rules of etiquette apply. This includes maintaining a quiet atmosphere and refraining from bringing food or drink into the lab.
8. Inappropriate use of St. Patrick computer resources may result in disciplinary action, depending on the seriousness of the offense. This includes loss of computer privileges, financial reimbursement for damages inflicted on equipment, detention, suspension or expulsion.
9. Inappropriate use includes, but is not limited to:
  - Using copyrighted materials in reports without permission.
  - Misuse or tampering with computer equipment.
  - Accessing or using any file that contains inappropriate material, including materials deemed by the principal to be pornographic or obscene.
  - Intentionally introducing a computer virus on a St. Patrick School computer.
  - Sending a message under someone else's name.
  - Sending messages or accessing information that is sexist or racist in nature.
  - Any use of computer resources to facilitate illegal or personal gain.



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## Computer and Internet Use Agreement 2011 – 2012

We have read, understand, and will follow **St. Patrick Computer and Internet Use Policy** that applies to all students, staff and other persons using school computer resources.

We understand that any violation of this policy may lead to a loss of computer privileges and/or other disciplinary action if appropriate.

We understand that students of St. Patrick are given the privilege of a laptop computer to use during school at appropriate times. On occasion, a student may receive written permission from the teacher to take a laptop computer home.

We understand that the St. Patrick Computer and Internet Use Policy applies to the use of the computer while the computer is used at home, as well as during school time. If our student accesses the Internet while at home using a St. Patrick School computer, we (the student's parent/guardian) understand that we are responsible for monitoring the student's Internet access.

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## Parent Responsibilities and Commitments

I, \_\_\_\_\_, understand that being an St. Patrick Catholic School parent is not an easy undertaking. It is hard work. I fully commit to St. Patrick Catholic School, its faculty and its students. I will show my commitment to the school and to my child, \_\_\_\_\_, by supporting them in the following ways:

- I will ensure that my child arrives at school by 8:15 am and that they remain at school until 3:30 pm.
- I will contact the school in the case that my child is sick and cannot attend school. I will also make arrangements for receiving any assignments my child misses during their absence.
- I will carefully check my child's homework every night. I understand that if I take shortcuts and do not carefully check homework, my child is less likely to do well in school and in life.
- If my child has problems with their homework, I will ensure that s/he calls his/her classmate(s) or teacher, or I will find them another source to help them with their homework.
- I will not give my child answers or do their work for them. I understand that the process and struggle of learning will help prepare them for success later in life.
- I understand that if my child needs serious academic help, s/he will be required to stay after school and/or come to school during the summer.
- I understand that my child looks to me for guidance on how to act. I will exhibit an attitude of respect towards all St. Patrick teachers, staff, volunteers and guests with the expectation that my child will emulate it.
- I understand that I am responsible for the behavior and actions of my child. The school is not responsible for the behavior and actions of my child.
- I will make sure my child follows the school dress code and rules.
- I will treat all enrichment staff, volunteers and guests with the respect I am expected to show other St. Patrick staff members and expect my child to do the same.
- I will carefully read all communications that the school sends home to me. I will not sign anything that my child asks me to sign until I have read it and fully understand what I am signing.
